EVERY FOSTER CHILD, AGE 6-12,
A LIFE CHANGING CAMP

We, _____ (name of sponsoring church or non-profit organization and city, state), will launch a local Royal Family KIDS Camp on or about _____. On behalf of the sponsor, we acknowledge the following:

(1) **RFK RULES AND POLICIES:** In operating our Camp, we agree to follow the rules and policies stated in the RFK Director's Manual and any updates we receive from RFK, specifically including all policies and rules regarding background-checking, reference checking, and training of volunteers; staffing with required professional and other volunteer adults; and protecting the children by following RFK rules regarding physical safety such as "two deep," photography restrictions, and the other rules contained in the Directors' Manual. We also understand that as a local Camp we are legally and financially responsible for our Camp, and for following applicable county, state and federal laws concerning both volunteers working with foster children and the foster children themselves. We also agree that prior to commencement of Camp activities, we will inform our insurance carrier about our Royal Family KIDS Camp program, and confirm that our insurance covers both volunteers and children, in the minimum amounts of \$1 million general liability and \$500,000 sexual misconduct. We agree to add RFK as an additional insured on the policy as regards our Camp, and to hold RFK harmless from any wrongful acts on our part.

(2) **RFK CAMPER CONTACT POLICY:** We understand that camper contact policies adopted by RFK protect both RFK and the sponsoring church or 501(c)(3). There will be no contact with campers after Camp has concluded, except through our RFK Club/Mentor Program or individual arrangements with the applicable social services agency. If we undertake any additional or different outreach efforts for abused or at-risk children, we will not connect that unaffiliated effort in any way to RFK, and we will observe the rules prohibiting contacting campers in the name of Royal Family KIDS for any activity other than RFK participation. We understand that this policy helps protect us both from violating state and local confidentiality laws regarding children under court order.

(3) **RFK TRADEMARK POLICY:** We acknowledge and agree that RFK has created a unique trademarked name, logo, brand identity, and materials, as included on its website. We agree to follow all procedures and restrictions regarding non-permitted use of the RFK name, logo, and other materials. We agree that we will not duplicate, print, stitch, or screen the RFK name or logo on apparel, jewelry or novelty/gift items, nor will we use the name or logo on a website that is not in compliance with RFK website policies.

(4) **RFK CERTIFICATION PROGRAM:** We understand that participation in the RFK Camp Network is limited to Camps in good standing with a current Certification. We understand that our annual Certification as a local RFK Camp is conditional upon meeting the standards contained in the Directors' Manual, with updates, supplied to us. We will submit the annual Camp Certification review materials within four weeks after our Camp each year in order to keep RFK apprised of our compliance and status as a Camp. Upon submission, RFK will issue its annual certification, or notify us of any changes required for Certification.
