

Prayers For Campers

One of our volunteers adapted these scriptures as prayers for Campers. Feel free to use them as you pray for your Campers or use this as a model for adapting other scriptures to specifically pray for campers.

Adapted from: Ephesians 1:17b-19a; Ephesians 3:14-21; Philippians 4:4-9; Colossians 1:9b-12;

Dearest Lord,

I do not cease giving thanks for these children who You have given to us, while making mention of them in my prayers; that You, the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give campers a spirit of wisdom and of revelation in the knowledge of You. I pray that the eyes of their hearts may be enlightened, so that these dear ones will know what is the hope of Your calling, what are the riches of the glory of Your inheritance in the saints, and what is the surpassing greatness of Your power toward us who believe.

For this reason I bow before You, dear Father, from whom every family in heaven and on earth derives its name, that You would grant these dear ones, according to the riches of Your glory, to be strengthened with power through Your Spirit in their souls, so that Christ may dwell in their hearts through faith; and that they, being rooted and grounded in love, may be able to comprehend with all the saints what is the breadth and length and height and depth, and to know the love of Christ which surpasses knowledge, that they may be filled up to all the fullness of You, Lord God. Now to You who are able to do far more abundantly beyond all that we ask or think, according to the power that works within us, to You be the glory in the church and in Christ Jesus to all generations forever and ever. Truly, I pray.

I pray, dear Lord, that these dear ones will rejoice in the Lord always; again I will say, rejoice! I pray that their gentle spirit be known to all people. You, O Lord, are near. May they be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving may their requests be made known to You, O God. And Your peace, which surpasses all comprehension, will guard their hearts and their minds in Christ Jesus. Finally, whatever is true, whatever is honorable, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is of good repute, if there is any excellence and if anything worthy of praise, I pray that [Camper names] will dwell on these things. The things they have learned and received and heard and seen in the body of Christ, I pray that they will practice these things, and the God of peace will be with them.

I have not ceased to pray for them and to ask that they may be filled with the knowledge of Your will in all spiritual wisdom and understanding, so that they will walk in a manner worthy of You, dear Lord, to please You in all respects, bearing fruit in every good work and increasing in the knowledge of You; strengthened with all power, according to Your glorious might, for the attaining of all steadfastness and patience; joyously giving thanks to the You, O Father, who have qualified us to share in the inheritance of the saints in Light.

These sample Bible passages have been adapted to personalize prayers for Campers. You can adapt many more.

Salvation: 2 Cor. 6:2—For God says, at just the right time, I heard you. On the day of salvation, I helped you. Indeed, the right time is now. Today is the day of salvation for **[Camper Name]**

Growth in Grace: 2 Peter 3:18a—I pray that **[Camper Name]** may grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.

Love for God's Word: Ps. 19:10— May **[Camper Name]** grow to find Your word more precious than much pure gold and sweeter than honey from the comb.

Wholeness in Christ: Eph. 2:10—Help **[Camper Name]** know that they are God's masterpiece He created us anew in Christ Jesus, so we can do the good things he planned for us long ago.

Faith: Col. 2:7—Let **[Camper Name]** roots grow down into Him, and let your lives be built on Him. Then your faith will grow strong in the truth you were taught, and you will overflow with thankfulness.

Cling to God: Ps. 63:8— May **[Camper Name]** cling to you and know that your strong right hand holds **[Camper Name]** securely.

Passion for God: Phil. 3:13a—That **[Camper Name]** may focus on this one thing: Forgetting the past and looking forward to what lies ahead.
