

CAMP COMMANDMENTS

The following are the typical Camp Rules rewritten in the Old Testament style language.

(Please see your Camp Manuals for details on each rule & additional rules, these are just abbreviations. 101 C/S Manual Sec. V. pg 7-12; Directors Manual Sec.1-10-1 / 1-10-4.)

1. Thou shalt always find thyself with a fellow companion amongst the least of these.
- "Two Deep". This means that there will be two adults at ALL times when you are in the company of a camper. One adult with one camper is NEVER allowed. NEVER allow your campers to be alone without at least 2 adults accompanying them.
2. Thou shalt always keep thy interior doors open when two adjoining dwellings are used. Exterior doors need not be open lest thou welcome unwanted travelers & common varmints from the hills of the Negev.
- "Open Doors" – Keep adjoining room doors open or ajar at least ten inches.
3. Thou shalt not lay on another's mat.
- "Beds Alone" – This applies to campers and counselors. Campers are never allowed to sit or lay on your bed, nor you on their bed.
4. Thou Shalt not obtain an eternal reflection of the least of these.
- NO CAMERAS or VIDEOS (except by the camp photographer(s)). This applies to both campers and counselors.
5. Honor the least of these and request their permission prior to touching.
- Ask permission from your campers whether it is okay for you to touch, hug, pat them or put your hand on their shoulder. "Safe Hugs" – These are hugs that are side-to-side and not face-to-face hugs. This kind of hug applies to campers, counselors and staff while at camp.
6. Honor thy schedule, and keep it with thee always.
- BE ON TIME and PARTICIPATE in all activities. Please follow the daily schedules.
7. Thou shalt sacrifice all thy medicinal herbs into the hands of thy "mid-wife".
- All medications in the vicinity of the campers (including vitamins and over-the-counter drugs), are to be turned in to the Nurse upon arrival at camp.

8. Thou shalt have order and purpose in thy dwelling.
- Clean your room daily. Help keep the camp clean and model this for your campers.
9. Thou shalt be known, always!
- NAME TAGS are to be worn at ALL times by EVERYONE, all week.
10. Observe thy tenants whense thou dippest in the Nile.
- Observe the pool rules. Campers are to wear their nametags to the pool to be checked in by an adult. All counselors must hand their campers over to a STAFF member before taking their break. BE ON TIME to pick up your campers at the end of the swim time.
11. Thou shalt not wear high heels whense crossing the Red Sea.
- Tennis shoes or any type of closed-toe shoes are to be worn at ALL times (with the exception of pool time). This applies to EVERYONE at camp.
12. Be ye careful whense thou consumeth the sweet nectar of the vine.
– Keep all snacks, candy and soft drinks out of view of your campers. Do not eat your snacks in front of your camper or bring snacks into the cabins. CANDY is not given to the children at ANY time.
13. Honor thee with silence and let thy cell phone ringeth NOT!
- Do not carry your cell phones – Cell Phones are only to be used at break time and must be kept at the Counselor break room. Campers are never allowed to use them.
14. Thou shalt not carry the burden of the least of these upon thy shoulder or upon thy lap.
- No piggy back rides or sitting on laps.
15. Share not thy ancestral dwelling location with the least of these. Nor thy Tentspace (MySpace), Facescroll, (Facebook), or personal tree carvings and hieroglyphics (BLOG / websites.)
- No sharing of personal addresses, phone numbers, or electronic addresses.
