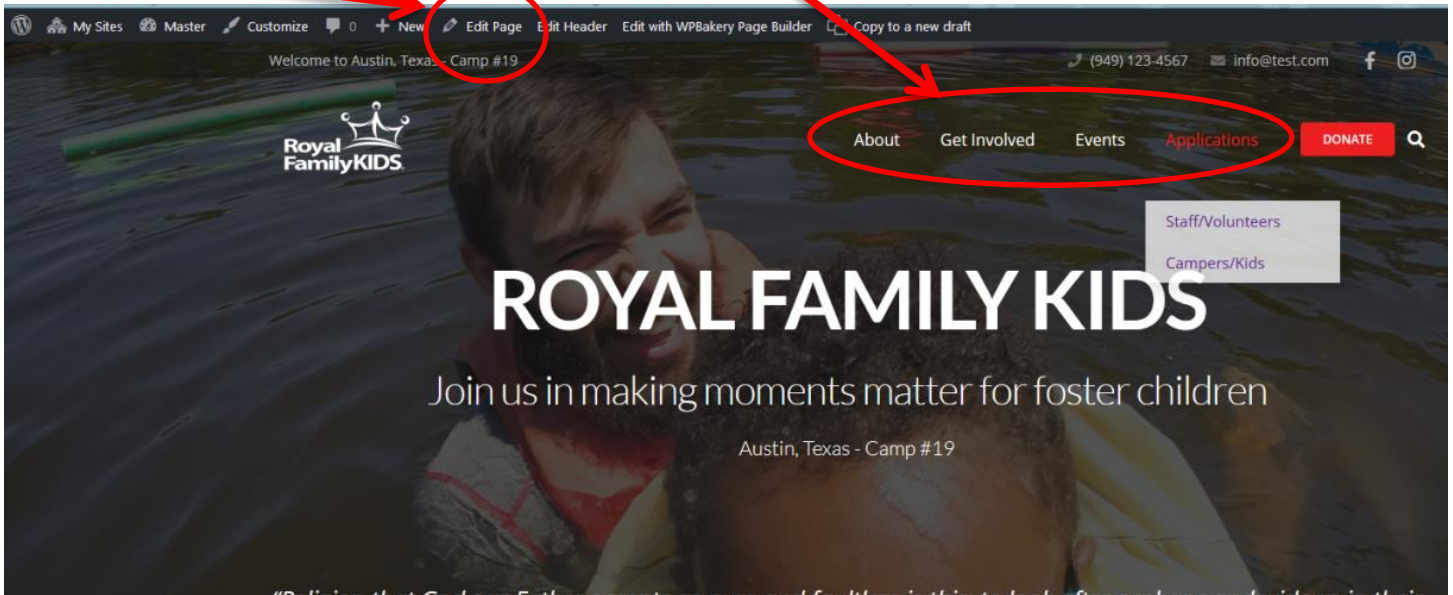
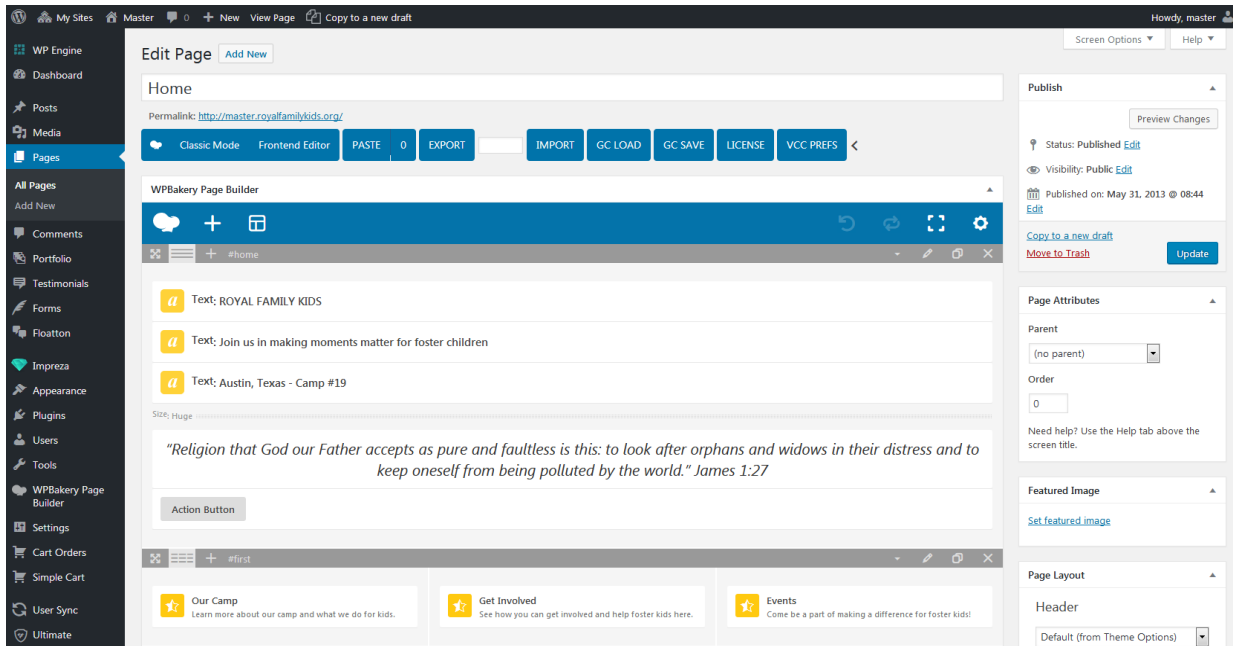


Edit the Menu along the top of the page

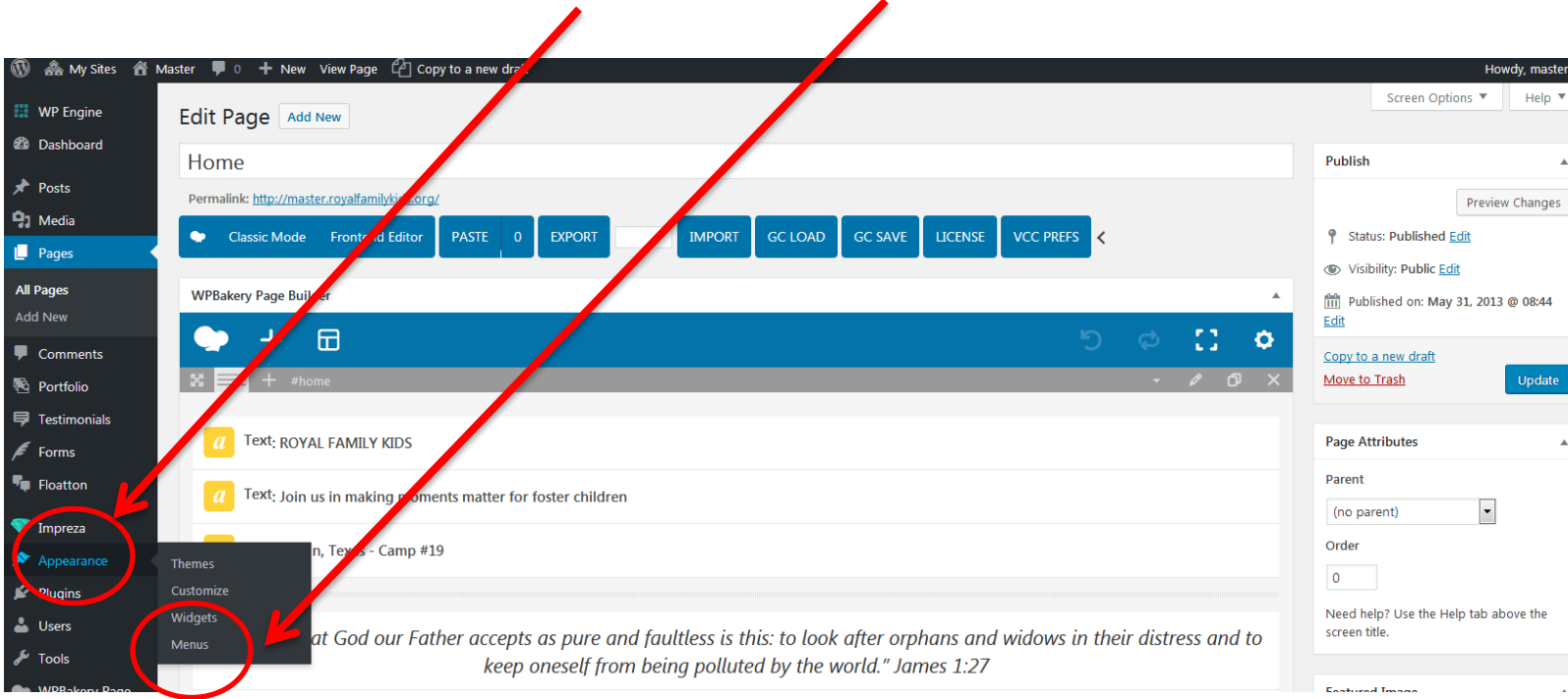
1. Go to master.royalfamilykids.org
2. Click on "Edit Page"



3. This page will appear

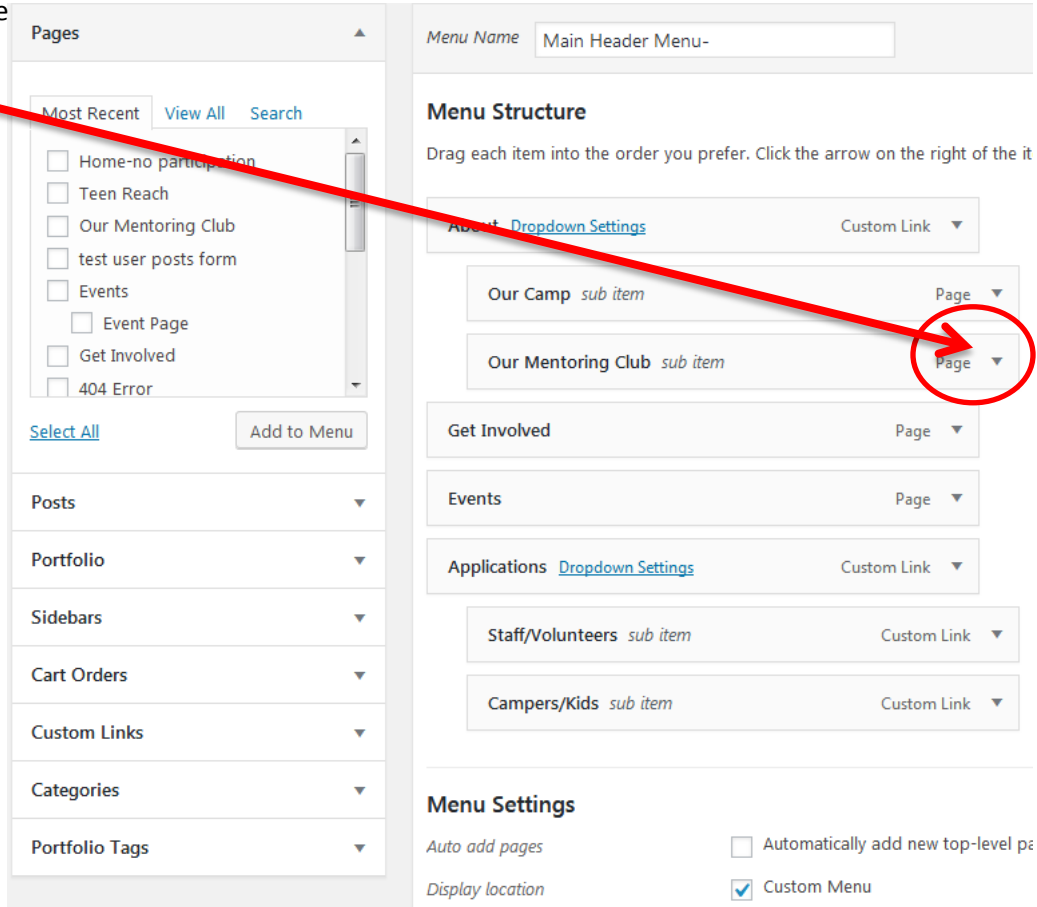


4. On the left side of the page, click on "Appearance" and then "Menus"



5. This is where you can edit what the menus along the top of the page are

6. If you want to delete or change the name of a Menu item, click the downward-facing arrow



Menu Structure

Drag each item into the order you prefer. Click the arrow on the right of the item

- 7. In the "Navigation Label" you can change the name of the Menu item
- 8. If you want to delete this Menu item, click "Remove"
- 9. Click "Save Menu" in the upper right hand corner
